- Performing field checks on Active Traffic Control devices.

- Diploma in Electrical, Electronic, Transportation or Civil Engineering Technology from a recognized institute of technology;
- Minimum of 2 years experience in traffic engineering field including the design and preparation of traffic controller programming sheets, drawings and maps.

- Completion of MicroStation, Level 1 and ability to use MS Office and MicroStation;
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively;
- Ability to work in all traffic and weather conditions;
- Possession of valid Alberta Class 5 driver's license
